2-.002.01	Armband	Nazi armband taken from a guard at Dachau concentration camp in April of 1945. It was donated by the Arrison family in honor of Lt. Col. John Goslin Gray, U.S. Army, who helped liberate the camp.
2-.016.02	Armband	Leather armband with a laminated paper with the star of David on it in the center worn by Jewish police in the ghetto of Lodz, Poland
1998.004.019	Banjo	Banjo made with a piece of the Torah
2006.009	Banner	Nazi banner with grommets. Size: 16'6" long x 5' high. Collected by Kenneth George Kraus (1919-2006)
19xx.009	Book	Yizkor Book in memory of the Jewish Community of Yanova. The book was made to remember all those who died during the Holocaust from the Yanova community.
2-.031.013	Book	A Siddur, which is a prayer book that came from the old synagogue in Krakow, Poland. It dates back to 1860 and survived the Nazi book burning and destruction of all Jewish religious manifestation in Poland
2004.003	Box, Cigarette	Cigarette box with an etching of the entrance to Dachau with the letters "SS". It was given to Lacern Gabriel by Dachau inmate Elisa, who later became Lacern's wife. He was with the United States Army and a member of the first platoon to enter the camp.
1988.005.02	Button, Military	Triangular badge inscribed "Nat. Soc. Frauenschaft" in gold at top with white cross on black background and red swastika in the center
1988.005.04	Button, Military	Oval metal pin with wreath round the outside, crossed swords in the center through a swastika
1998.004.003	Button, Military	Sondercommando button worn by inmates at Auschwitz working in the crematorium
2006.003.01	Button, Military	Three medals given to MP Private Albert P. Vannier from the German army during World War II
2-.016.03	Calendar	Calendar of 1944 from the ghetto of Lodz, Poland
2-.016.04	Calendar	Calendar of 1943 from the ghetto of Lodz, Poland
2-.016.05	Calendar	Calendar of 1942 from the ghetto of Lodz, Poland

2-.031.016	Currency	Paper money from 1943 worth zwanzig (20) kronen which was used strictly in the ghetto of Lodz, Poland and the Terezin concentration camp in Czechoslovakia, and was worthless elsewhere
2-.031.017	Currency	Paper money from 1943 worth zehn (10) Kronen which was used strictly in the ghetto of Lodz, Poland and the Terezin concentration camp in Czechoslovakia, and was worthless elsewhere

2-.045.01	Doll	Adult male doll, fully clothed, carrying gun; made by a mother for her child at a concentration camp
2-.045.02	Doll	Adult male doll, fully clothed in all black; made by a mother for her child at a concentration camp
2-.045.03	Doll	Adult male doll, clothed and wearing skis; made by a mother for her child at a concentration camp
2006.007	Drawing	Two framed drawings: one is of a rabbi studying alone and the second is of a rabbi teaching a group of children while a man looks on from behind. Both pictures were done by an artist who died in Auschwitz.
1998.004.002	Eyeglasses	Eyeglasses found at Auschwitz in black case
2005.001.001	Flag	Nazi Flag 5ft. X 4ft.
2006.01	Flag	Nazi flag 36' x 126' approx.

2-.009	Painting	Framed painting of the ship the "St. Louis". Originally owned by Howard Manerd Harris, the great-grandfather of Jeff Bennett
1988.005.05	Patch	Patch in the shape of eagle holding a swastika in its claw.
2007.007.05	Record, Phonograph	Recorded music given by Blossom Strutin to her husband Irving
2-.031.011	Records	A type of official documentation from 1946
2-.031.023	Sculpture	Copper sculpture from 1969 by Kenneth Treister titled Auschwitz
2-.021.024	Sculpture	Copper sculpture from 1969 by Kenneth Treister titled Exodus
2-.046	Sculpture	Copper Sculpture by Wolf Kahn titled Sharing Survivors, depicting two emaciated men huddled under a shared blanket
2-.046.01	Sculpture	Copper Sculpture by Wolf Kahn titled Wringing Away Sorrows, depicting a woman wringing out wet clothing. Dedicated to Ruth Carp, based on true story of survivor Janet Back
2-.046.02	Sculpture	Copper Sculpture by Wolf Kahn titled The Soldier and the Survivor, depicting a soldier carrying an emaciated Survivor over his shoulder
2007.007.06	Silverware	Eating utensils and container used by Irving Strutin during his time in the Army
2-.031.022	Silverware	Metal spoon that belonged to a prisoner in the Auschwitz concentration camp
2-.020	Soap	Bar of soap that was given to prisoners at a Nazi concentration camp during World War II
2-.031.027	Stone, worked	Piece of the Berlin Wall mounted in clear plastic and inscribed "13.August 1961 - 9.November 1989 Freiheitswille bricht mauern"
1998.004.018	Tefillin	Prayer shawl found at Auschwitz
2-.007	Typewriter	Historical typewriter that was originally owned by Endre Bajcsy Zsilinszky in Hungary in 1944. He was jailed and executed and the typewriter was given to Tibor Helvey who Endre met in jail. It was eventually given to the Folsom family.
1988.005.01	Undershirt	Thin cotton shirt with black eagle and swastika on front
19xx.004	Uniform	Prisoner uniform belonging to Josef Himmelblau worn while he was a prisoner in the Pustkow concentration camp from 1942 to 1944.
2-.019	Watch, Pocket	Pocket watch belonging to Jim Hiscock, S/Sgt 35th Supply Company, 8th Corps Troops, British Second Army. He was one of the liberators of the Bergen-Belsen concentration camp in April of 1945
2-.022	Whip	Whip used by guards in concentration camps against the prisoners. It was picked up by Donald Lewis in 1945 after he had been a part of liberating a camp
